December was a very busy month. Gospel Light Baptist Church held its Christmas Cantata on Dec. 10. We worked together with Promised Land Baptist Church to produce an 80-voice choir. Many visitors came out to hear God’s Word in song and script. Ate Jeanne’s and my landlady, Mrs. Mila Fider, accepted our invitation to attend. We were thrilled to see her come out, although she did not stay for the whole hour. Please continue to pray for her salvation.

Our church choir presented our cantata again on Dec. 13. The choir sang in the lobby of the Philippine Heart Center. Many people stopped to listen as the choir sang and Pastor Castillo shared the Gospel.

Asenath Cadavos, my co-teacher, gave two Christmas concerts entitled “Songs for His Joy and Delight.” One was in Manila at Gospel Light Baptist Church, and the other was in Malaybalay, Bukidnon on the island of Mindanao. I enjoyed accompanying on the piano for her and playing two Christmas solos. Asenath’s parents are missionaries in Mindanao, and they have a church and school ministry. Our concert in Bukidnon raised funds for Casisang Christian School and provided a witnessing opportunity to the community. After our concert, one person commented that the theatre building was originally designed for the kind of music we presented instead of the modern-day rock music.
