Dear Family and Friends:

“Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened” (Matt. 7:7-8). I saw a plaque with these verses on it at a church I recently visited. Every time I walked by, the Lord spoke to me through the verses about my need to pray more about His provision for the mission field. I am excited to share that another church recently committed to help support my ministry, bringing my total support level up to 52%!

Often we consider the “mission field” to be some foreign land. That “mission field,” however, is right on our doorstep. I visited yard sales this past Saturday in Memphis, Tennessee, and the first house I stopped at had two Filipina ladies. I spoke to them in Tagalog, witnessed to them, and invited them to attend a service at the local Baptist church I am visiting while in the Memphis. These ladies are both Catholic.

I praise the Lord for His provision of a set of music education textbooks from a library in northern Pennsylvania. The books are in excellent condition and will be a wonderful resource for training my young teachers in the Philippines. The Lord also provided a set of 25 resonator bells for a reasonable price. Resonator bells are invaluable in music education.

A church in Indiana designated their Vacation Bible School offering towards printing my “Melodies of Joy” piano books in the Philippines. Please pray for the workers at New Song Ministries as they complete layout, printing, and binding for this project. These hymn arrangement books will provide a much-needed resource for training church musicians in the Philippines.
